FROM THE PRINCIPAL Dear Parents and Friends,



Welcome back to Term 2. I hope you all had a relaxing holiday and enjoyed having the children at home on holidays rather than learning remotely this time. I'm sure the students have come back eager to do lots of learning. This will be a very exciting term with lots happening.

STAFFING

Ms Bryan has been appointed acting Principal of Kingsbury Primary for this term. We hope Ms Bryan enjoys her time at the school. Mr Hunt and Ms Katsonis will be sharing the acting

Assistant Principal role this term. Ms Micallef will be the acting Leading Teacher for this term. Congratulations to these teachers. We welcome Ms Kanoun who will be grade sharing 2MK with Ms Micallef. Ms Selamet will be in 5/6S for the majority of the week.

RAMADAN

A number of our community members are observing Ramadan, with some of our students abstaining from food and drink during daylight hours. It is during this time that we respectfully ask families and staff to support one another by engaging in conversation should any students find this challenging. This could include actions such as encouraging students to reduce high physical activities throughout the day, having an appropriate night's sleep, as well as sharing any concerns which are impacting the student. Staff may contact families to check if their students are fasting so that they can best support them at school. Families are encouraged to update the school or the classroom teacher to provide advice or guidance. Thank you for your understanding.

SCHOOL TIMES

All children must be picked up by 3.45pm. School finishes at 3.30pm and children will be supervised until 3.45. Teachers then have meetings to attend. As we are heading into the colder weather, children should not be left out in the cold, waiting to be picked up after school.

NAPLAN

Students in grades 3 and 5 are going to be involved years 3 and 5 in the National Assessment Program in Literacy and Numeracy in May. This will provide the school and parents with data about student achievement at a point in time. Teachers can then use this information along with other forms of assessment to plan for improvement in student achievement.

As students will be completing NAPLAN online this year, it will be completed within a two week period from May 11th to May 21st.

YEAR 6 -7 TRANSITION

It is that time of the year where year 6 students and their parents need to choose a secondary school. I encourage you to take the opportunity to visit schools and attend information sessions at the secondary schools to make an informed decision and choose the school that suits your child. Year 6 students will be receiving transition forms to complete in the next week. Families will be able to use the 'Find My School' department website to find the local school for their children. This is the school which your child is designated to attend according to your home address. There is a new school opening up, Greenvale Secondary College, which some students will be designated to attend. Some schools have an enrolment ceiling and won't enrol students from outside the area.

ENROLMENTS 2022

We are now taking enrolments for 2022. Parents will need to bring along a birth certificate or passport as well as immunisation records to the office to enrol at the school. If you wish to enrol a child for Foundation (Prep), they must turn five before April 30th, 2022.

The Compass School Manager App


You can use the Compass app to action tasks. The app is available to download for free from the Apple App Store or the Google Play store.

Once installed and opened for the first time, you will be prompted to choose which school your child attends.

After selecting the school, you will be required to enter your login details which are the same details you use to login to your Compass parent portal.


When logged in, you will see -

- Each of your children who attend the school. You can click their image to go to their profiles.
- The option to add an attendance note
- Any items requiring your action (alerts) at the top of the screen.
- The newsfeed which you can scroll down through to read.
- A link to the main menu (three little stripes in top left corner



The Home Page

When logged in, you will be on the Home page. Here you will see different sections of key information.



Alerts - These are clickable notifications of items that require your action.

Newsfeed - These are posts made by the school to communicate school information to you. You can scroll through any available posts and they will remain accessible for as long as the school has determined. They will generally display with the most recently dated post at the top however, posts set as 'Priority' by the school will show first regardless of the date.

Child Information - You will see each child you have at the school listed and clickable items that give you further details i.e clicking 'View Academic Reports' will take you to your child's available reports

Menu options - Across the top of the screen you will see a series of icons that open up menus for additional information you may require to access from time to time i.e. access to placing a canteen order, access to viewing upcoming event information etc.

How to Access Compass

Compass is a web-based system that is accessible on any modern web browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari etc).

Every family receives a separate login to our school's Compass site. This login information is provided to you by the school.
