Rationale

Bethal Primary School recognises the importance of transition to school for students. Building strong partnerships with children and their families is an important part of our transition sessions. Ensuring effective and positive transitions supports the continuity of a child's learning and development. Our transition program provides opportunities to:

- Build positive relationships with the child and the teachers
- Help us understand how to support the child's safety and well-being at school
- Provide us with a child's level of learning and development
- Determine a child's preferred approaches to learning new things
- Understand how the child has developed and other skills they are working on
- See the child's level of independence
- Know the types of support required for the child when they begin school
- Plan for potential modifications required within the school environment
- Answer any questions or concerns that the families may have
